

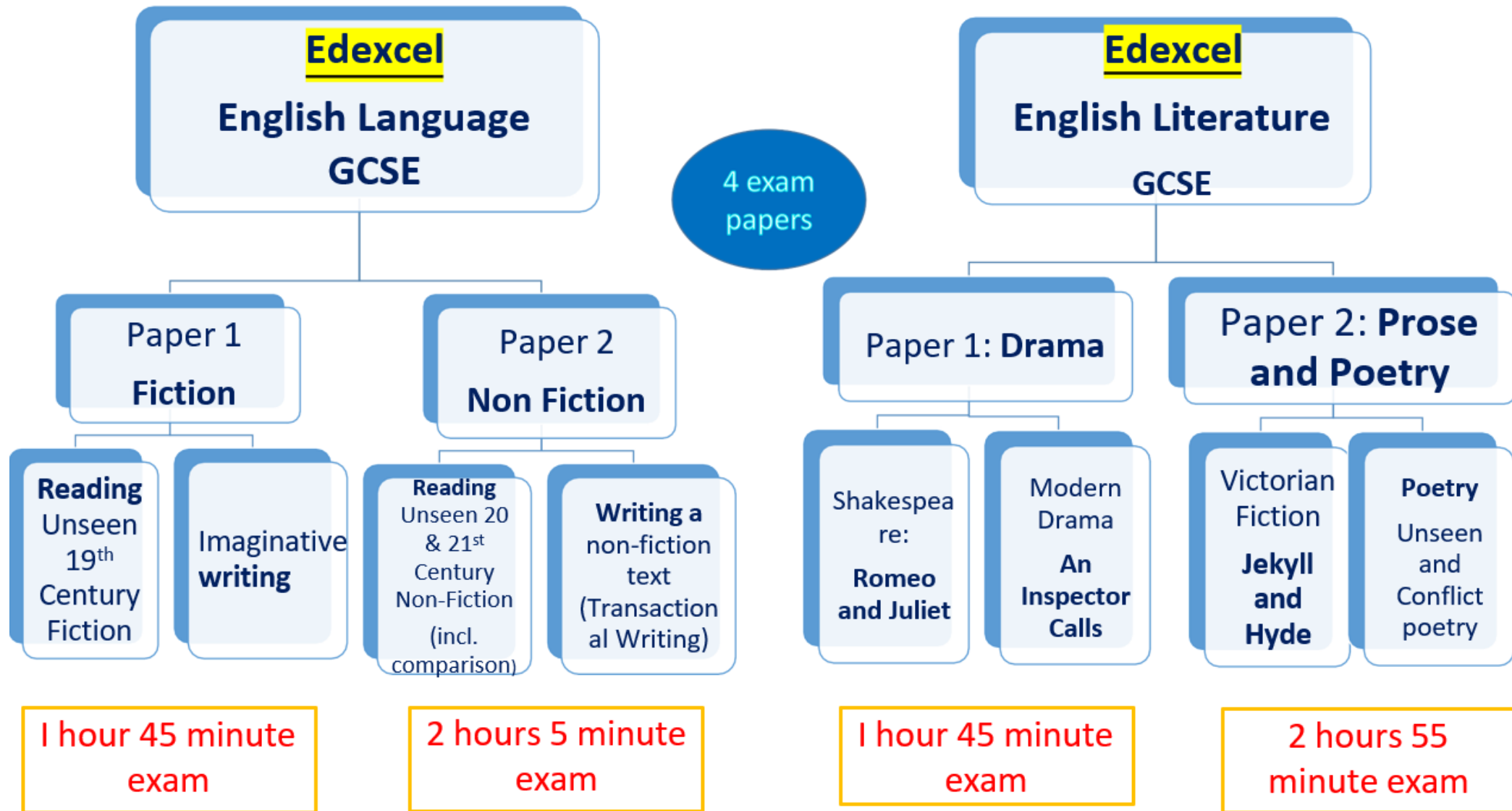

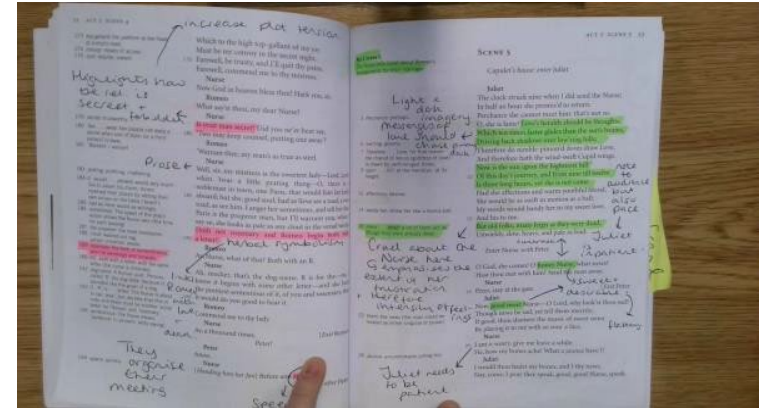
Students have 5 hours of English per week:

- Practising past papers questions available on Edexcel Pearson Website (planning and/or writing responses)

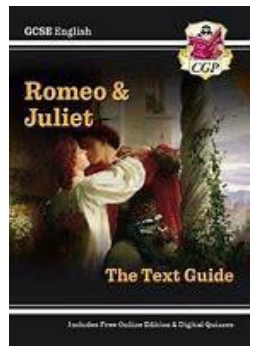
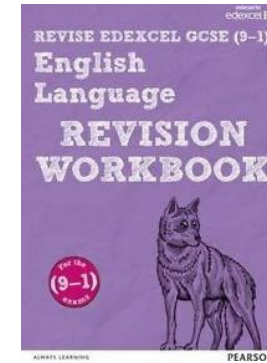


For Literature:
