Dear Parents/Carers,

Dropping off and picking up students from St Andrew the Apostle School

I am writing to inform you about dropping off and picking up arrangements for the start of this academic year.

I am delighted that preparation for our new school site has started. Because of this, arrangements for dropping off and picking up students from our school on the North London Business Park have changed.

From the start of term, Wednesday 7 September 2022, if you wish to drop off your child at school, you must use the Brunswick Park Road entrance to the North London Business Park.

As a reminder, there is a staggered start to the school day on Wednesday 7 September. Please see details below:

Wednesday 7 September 2022	Arrival Times	Building	Key instructions
Year 7	8.25am	4	Students should line up in single file by the glass doors leading into building 4, along the demarcated area.
Year 8	9.45am	5	Students should wait in the canteen in Building 5.
Year 9	9.45am	4	Students should line up in the upper school playground.
Year 10	10.35am	5	Students should wait in the main playground in Building 5.
Year 11	10.35am	5	Students should wait by the ball court in Building 5.
Year 12	9.30am	4	Students should enter the building and wait for their form tutors on the grass area in the inner courtyard of B4.
Year 13	10.35am	4	Students should enter the building and make their way to the sixth form area where they will be directed to their form rooms

There will be more changes from 19 September 2022 as work becomes more advanced. At this point the only access to school for vehicles and pedestrians will be through the Oakleigh Road entrance. This is a significant change and students who normally get local buses to Brunswick Park Road will have to get off the bus at the closest stop to Brunswick Crescent or Brunswick Avenue, where they will walk around to the Oakleigh Road entrance. If you wish to drop your child off at school, please access the North London Business Park via Oakleigh Road, where you will be directed around the multi-storey car park; drop off will take place in the bays in front of the multi-storey car park.

I recognise that this may add additional time to your/your child's journey time. Please adjust your travel time accordingly such that your child is able to arrive at school in time.

To reduce your travel time and to lessen traffic to make the roads near our school safer (and with a view on working towards goals in the travel plan for our new school building), please look at alternatives to dropping off your children on the school site, which is served well by a number of different bus routes. You may also wish to use 'ride and stride', dropping off your child a couple of roads away from site such that they can walk the remainder of the way to school.
